

INSTRUCTIONS FOR INCOMING INTERNATIONAL WIRES IN U.S. DOLLARS

First National Bank uses a correspondent or intermediary bank (PNC BANK N.A.) to receive wires through the SWIFT System. Our name appears in Field 59 which is designated as the beneficiary with the 10 digit account number listed below. Field 70 is designated as a Originator to Beneficiary information field and is where the FNB customer name, address and account number should be listed. These instructions must be complete **AND** be sent in **US dollars** for the wire to arrive.
